- Pastor updates
  - Still in need of a religious ed coordinator (and catechists)
  - In need of new fifth grade teacher and still looking for a second grade teacher
  - Capital campaign update
    - We are in the feasibility study phase – should have understanding in approximately five weeks
      - Original goal of \$1,000,000
      - Additional projects beyond that being considered (does not include convent)
    - Convent is additional \$2-3 million, likely to be raised throughout the Archdiocese
    - CCS is the campaign consultant
  - No update on the boiler
  - Handmaids of the Heart of Jesus - any agreement must wait until after they meet their new bishop
- Pretzel Run - ministries should have a presence at the run, running or otherwise
- September – theme is the Mass
  - Kneelers now placed permanently in the church
- October – Respect Life and Month of the Rosary
  - There will be collections for Women's Care Center and Women's Support Center
  - Spiritual Adoption program will end
  - Respect Life Committee
    - Working with Deacon Jim at the Archdiocese to get some materials
    - Procured a statue with literature at the back of church
