- Opening prayer – 6:38pm
- Minutes approved
- Eucharistic Revival summary
 - Council agrees to once monthly overnight adoration (between Saturday and Sunday Masses) on second Saturdays, beginning December
 - Alice Wycklendt can coordinate the sign up schedule
- Council deferred formation video to another meeting when more members are in attendance
 - Prayer and Worship Committee has been implementing more formation opportunities at meetings
- Human Concerns might benefit from some central leadership to better coordinate and build/expand ministries
 - Be a face/point of contact for parishioners looking to get involved
 - Help coordinate collections/projects to better space out and time over course of the year
 - Vote on fifth Sunday collections
- Encouraging participation among additional parishioners/school families
 - Ministry fair – family night with information/interaction with available ministries, make it a celebration of everything we do
 - Cory is going to contact Peter to see when gym is available (targeting January)
- Good Soil Initiative
 - Two women's groups established, men's group being formed
 - Visioning team doubled in size
- Fr. Enrique updates
 - Finance Council has approved the larger capital campaign for \$2.5 million
 - Boilers – need to be replaced, need to get bids
 - Church renovation – redo the floor, refinish the pews, remove pews from the back to provide more space, restore the sanctuary to prior format with more room at the front, improve lighting
 - Parking lot resurface
 - Kitchen and windows in the school are being deferred
 - Working on a path/mechanism for broader parish communication about the capital campaign
 - Aiming to begin campaign in January
- Review of October and "Respect Life" month
 - Many simultaneous efforts that could benefit from more coordination
 - December is likely to be similar
- November and December themes
 - School students are doing projects to be displayed in the back of church
 - Sons of the Parish Mass
 - Celebrating all those men who have been part of St. Robert
 - Ideally have time to interact with priests in attendance briefly after Mass
- Stewardship committee is still in need of a chair
